

Where Can I Get Help?

District level ESE personnel are available to provide assistance to parents, teachers, administrators and students throughout the school district.	
ESE General Director	Lead administrator responsible for Exceptional Student Education programs, procedures and personnel.
Velasco ESE Supervisors	Supervisors based at the Velasco Student Services Center responsible for supervisory and administrative duties for specific Exceptional Student Education programs district-wide.
ESE Compliance Supervisor	Supervisor responsible for Exceptional Student Education Compliance procedures and issues.
ESE Staffing Supervisor	Supervisor responsible for Exceptional Student Education Staffing procedures and for Staffing personnel.
Area ESE Supervisors	Supervisors responsible for Exceptional Student Education programs, procedures and personnel within their assigned district area. Each Area District Office has one ESE Supervisor.
Area ESE District Resource Teachers	Assist school personnel in implementing Exceptional Student Education programs and procedures. Each Area District Office has one ESE District Resource Teacher to service assigned area schools.
Area ESE Specialists	Assist District Office ESE Teams in providing assistance to school personnel in implementing Exceptional Student Education programs and procedures. ESE Specialists are assigned to District Offices based on the need for additional ESE personnel for workload support.
Staffing Coordinators	Responsible for the Staffing Office in his or her Area District Office, as well as procedures and staffing and compliance issues within the assigned district area.
Staffing Specialists	Staffing Specialists chair eligibility staffing meetings and/or Individual Educational Plan meetings, as necessary. They also provide inservice and assistance to schools relating to issues of compliance.
Program Coordinators	Responsible for administrative oversight district-wide in implementing programs and procedures related to their specifically assigned Exceptional Student Education programs.
Velasco District Resource Teachers	Perform duties as assigned by supervisory personnel. They offer assistance to school and district personnel and parents, as needed.
Florida Diagnostic and Learning Resources Staff	Provides support services to educators, parents and other personnel involved in the education of children identified as eligible for ESE services or at-risk children.
Florida Instructional Materials Center for the Visually Impaired Staff	Provides Braille, large print and recorded materials, and specialized equipment to students with visual impairments enrolled in Florida's public and private schools.
ACAT Team	Team members available as a resource to school personnel and parents in the area of <u>alternative communication and assistive technology</u> for Exceptional Education students.
Parent Liaisons	Provide support and information to parents of students identified as ESE who are attending schools within their assigned District Areas.
